Companies can enjoy Absentee Payroll (AP) when sending their employees for training during and after working hours*.

After Working Hours (mandatory top-up by employers to enjoy AP)	Subject to employer top- up of balance 20% of hourly basic salary, capped at \$1.10/hr for training outside working hours.	Subject to employer top- up of balance 20% of hourly basic salary, capped at \$1.90/hr for training outside working hours.	Subject to employer top- up of balance 5% of hourly basic salary for training outside working hours.

WDA Funding Policy:
